GLEN ROCK BOROUGH AWARDED DCED GRANT FOR PROJECT 2016

Glen Rock Borough was awarded the Greenways, Trails and Recreation Program Grant from the Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development (DCED). The Glen Rock Recreation Board applied for the grant in June 2015 on behalf of Glen Rock Borough. The award is in the amount of \$150,510 and will be used for upgrading and expanding the community park at 5400 Fair School Rd. Renovations will including providing ADA accessibility and the addition of a dog park.

Project 2016 is set to begin as soon as funding is released and weather permits. This project was financed in part by a grant from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Commonwealth Financing Authority.
