HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS



WALK SAFELY

- Cross the street at corners, using traffic signals and crosswalks.
- Always walk on sidewalks or paths. If there are no sidewalks, walk facing traffic as far to the left as possible. Children should walk on direct routes with the fewest street crossings.



TRICK OR TREAT WITH AN ADULT

- Children under the age of 12 should not be alone at night without adult supervision. If kids are mature enough to be without supervision, they should stick to familiar areas that are well lit and trick-or-treat in groups.



KEEP COSTUMES CREATIVE AND SAFE

- Decorate costumes and bags with reflective tape or stickers and, if possible, choose light colors.
- Have kids carry glow sticks or flashlights to help them see and be seen by drivers.



DRIVE EXTRA SAFELY ON HALLOWEEN

- Drive slowly, anticipate heavy pedestrian traffic and turn your headlights on earlier in the day to spot children from greater distances.
- Popular trick-or-treating hours are 5:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. so be especially alert to kids during those hours.

PROJECT 2016

Glen Rock Borough was awarded the Greenways, Trails and Recreation Program Grant from the Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development (DCED) in June of 2015. The award was used to upgrade and expand the Glen Rock Community Park. Renovations included making the park ADA accessible and the addition of a community dog park. A ribbon cutting was held on September 23, 2017 at the annual 5K9 Bark for the Park, an event to benefit the *Glen Rock Recreation Fund*.

This project was financed in part by a grant from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Commonwealth Financing Authority.

WINTER STORM EMERGENCY ROUTES

PARKING WILL BE PROHIBITED on posted Winter Storm Emergency Routes: Church, Main, Manchester, Baltimore, Hanover, Valley and Water Streets.



Winter Storm Emergency Routes are put into place to regulate traffic and parking of vehicles during periods of winter storms/snowfall. When a Winter Storm Emergency is declared it will be in effect for up to 24 hours following net accumulation of snow/ice or until roadways are cleared. More information is available on the borough website.

****Vehicles parked on Emergency Routes when a Winter Storm Emergency has been declared will be towed at the owner's expense. ****

Property owners **must shovel their sidewalks within 24 hours of the end of snow-fall.** Snow may not be shoveled back into the plowed street. Please keep your sidewalks free of snow & ice!
