Old Business

<u>Taps-</u> Mr. Josh Corney, Mr. Glenn Engles and Mr. Mike Sharkey joined us to discuss having the Taps Memorial placed at the Glen Rock Park along with the speakers as opposed to having it at the downtown memorial location and a smaller plaque at the park as previously discussed.
