- **Police Services:** New Freedom's future in SRPD continues to evolve. Stay tuned for developments.
- **Traffic Calming:** PennDOT will be changing the signs restricting trucks on Church Street. New regulation compliant signs should be installed by the end of April.
- **Rockville Road Property:** We are having the property assessed to help determine a sales price.
