HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS

WALK SAFELY

- Cross the street at corners, using traffic signals and crosswalks.
- Always walk on sidewalks or paths. If there are no sidewalks, walk facing traffic as far to the left as possible. Children should walk on direct routes with the fewest street crossings.

TRICK OR TREAT WITH AN ADULT

- Children under the age of 12 should not be alone at night without adult supervision. If kids are mature enough to be without supervision, they should stick to familiar areas that are well lit and trick-or-treat in groups.

KEEP COSTUMES CREATIVE AND SAFE

- Decorate costumes and bags with reflective tape or stickers and, if possible, choose light colors.
- Have kids carry glow sticks or flashlights to help them see and be seen by drivers.

DRIVE EXTRA SAFELY ON HALLOWEEN

- Drive slowly, anticipate heavy pedestrian traffic and turn your headlights on earlier in the day to spot children from greater distances.
- Popular trick-or-treating hours are 5:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. so be especially alert to kids during those hours.

WINTER STORM EMERGENCY ROUTES



PARKING WILL BE PROHIBITED on posted Winter Storm Emergency Routes: Church, Main, Manchester, Baltimore, Hanover, Valley and Water Streets.

Winter Storm Emergency Routes are put into place to regulate traffic and parking of vehicles during periods of winter storms/snowfall. When a Winter Storm Emergency is declared it will be in effect for up to 24 hours following net accumulation of snow/ice or until roadways are cleared. Declarations will be posted on the borough website, Facebook page, and local TV news stations.

****Vehicles parked on Emergency Routes when a Winter Storm Emergency has been declared will be towed at the owner's expense. ****

Property owners must shovel their sidewalks within 24 hours of the end of snow-fall. Snow may not be shoveled back into the plowed street. PLEASE keep your sidewalks free of snow & ice!
