



GLEN ROCK PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

BOROUGH OF GLEN ROCK YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET

The Borough of Glen Rock Pedestrian Safety Improvements Project involves pedestrian facility improvements along Main Street (SR 0216) from Water Street to Hanover Street. The project is located in Glen Rock Borough, York County, approximately 3 miles west of Interstate 83 (Capital Beltway); see attached Project Location Map.

The purpose of this project is to enhance pedestrian mobility along the Main Street (SR 0216) corridor. This project generally consists of the following improvements:

- Construction of a new 5' wide sidewalks along both the east and west side of the Main Street corridor between Water Street and Hanover Street.
- Narrowing the Main Street cartway width through the intersection with Water Street and Church Street (SR 3008).
- Construction of new crosswalks and associated curb ramps at the following locations:
 - Across Main Street at the Main Street / Water Street intersection. Pedestrian crossing warning signs will be installed in advance of the crosswalk.
 - Across Church Street at the Main Street / Church Street intersection.
 - Across Main Street at the crossing with The Heritage Rail Trail.
 - Across Main Street and Hanover Street at the Main Street / Baltimore Street (SR 0616) / Hanover Street intersection.
- Installation of a striped no parking zone at the northeast corner of the Main Street / Church Street intersection.
- Street trees will be planted at select locations to provide shade and project greening.
- Depressed curb/sidewalk will be installed to maintain driveway access while allowing for the continuation of the sidewalk.

ENVIRONMENTAL

A review of environmental resources, including cultural resources, determined the project is not anticipated to create adverse impacts to known environmental resources.

UTILITIES

The project will involve adjustments to storm sewer and utility appurtenances.

RIGHT OF WAY

There are anticipated to be temporary impacts to several properties by this project. No permanent right-of-way acquisitions are anticipated.

MAINTENANCE AND PROTECTION OF TRAFFIC


The sidewalks on either side of Main Street will be constructed in separate phases and a pedestrian detour will be implemented to maintain pedestrian access through the project area at all times during construction.

SCHEDULE AND FUNDING

Overall construction is anticipated to last approximately three (3) months. Project construction will be funded by a TASA (Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside) grant.
